By initialing in the blank next to each statement, you are committing to join with us in improving several areas of importance at our school. No child will be enrolled and included in a class without this sheet being filled out completely. We would ask that you seriously and prayerfully consider your responses.

_____ 1. I commit to helping with the fundraising efforts of the school throughout the entire school year. My faithfulness will help keep tuition as low as possible.

_____ 2. I commit to exhibiting speech toward and about school staff, teachers, students, and families that is edifying to people and glorifying to God. Any conversations, disagreements, and misunderstandings will be handled calmly, humbly, and lovingly. I commit to resolving any disagreement privately and personally with the person involved before anyone else is involved. My participation will not grieve the Holy Spirit, but will edify the brethren and be a great example to others.

_____ 3. I commit to having my children at school on time. Tardiness wastes class time and makes it difficult for the teachers to get their classes started. It is not good stewardship of time or money (including every family involved in that class). When I fail in this area, I am fully aware of the consequences as listed in the handbook. My punctuality will improve efficiency and encourage the teachers.

_____ 4. I commit to helping as a volunteer as frequently as possible, recognizing that excellent education requires a sacrifice of time and effort as well as finances. I realize that for my child to participate in programs like athletics, I must invest myself to make these programs possible and to help them run properly. My involvement helps spread the workload among everyone and patterns servant hood to the students.

_____ 5. I understand that, in the event a student leaves our school, no records, transcripts, or diplomas will be issued until the student’s account is paid in full.



2019-2020 PARENTS' AGREEMENT

We give permission for our child(ren) to take part in school activities, including sports and school-sponsored trips away from the school premises, and absolve the school from liability to us or our child(ren) at school or during any school activity.

We agree to uphold and support the high academic standards of Wayside Christian School by providing a place at home for our child(ren) to study and give our encouragement in the completion of homework and assignments.

We recognize that for our child(ren) to make good progress in his work, it is essential that he have confidence in his teachers and school. Therefore, we will do all in our power to see that our child(ren) respects and obeys the school staff and rules. We agree that if our child(ren) should become involved in any difficulty with other children in the school, we will in no case complain to any parent, but with a prayerful Christian spirit, will register only necessary complaints with the teacher or principal.

We consider it a real privilege to have the opportunity to send our child(ren) to Wayside Christian School and shall endeavor to support and uphold the principles and practices and educational policies of the school in every way.

We understand that the teacher and the administration are given full discretion in the disciplining of our child(ren). This includes the issuing of demerits, suspension, corporal punishment and expulsion from the school, and other discipline as outlined in the handbook. Detention halls may be used after school for various offenses. Transportation home will be parents' responsibility.

We agree to pay the first tuition payment by the date we have indicated. We understand that the other payments are due on or before the fifteenth (15) of the month, the last being due in May. After ten business days, a \$25.00 late fee will be added to accounts not paid. There is a \$20.00 fee for checks returned for non-sufficient funds. We further understand that any child whose account is sixty (60) days overdue will be subject to dismissal from school.
